


AUSTRALIA'S TIMELESS NORTH


BUNGLE BUNGLE

- ✖ Geological significance: None
- ✖ Host rock: Sandstone
- ✖ Age: Devonian
- ✖ Paragenesis: sediments with various amount of clay and different moisture content blue green algea again protect surface of the rock
- ✖ Significance: Mythical
- ✖ Mineralisation None



DEVONIAN CORAL REEFS

- ✖ Location: North side of Canning Basin
- ✖ Host rock: Limestone
- ✖ Age: Devonian
- ✖ Paragenesis: Coral reefs growing on basement in shallow
>150m water.
- ✖ Significance: Mythical, fabulous fossils, and cast topography
- ✖ Mineralisation Pb Zn
